Strategic Planning Update

Over the past several months, Strategic Planning efforts have focused on the development of a Mission and Vision Statement, which you will find on the cover of today's bulletin. The purpose of a Mission statement is to define our particular identity as a parish. This is the special purpose with which St. Matthew Parish works to build up God's Kingdom. The Vision Statement identifies how we plan to live out our Mission in this time and in this place.

Pentecost Sunday is the birthday of the Church. It is the day on which the Apostles receive the gift of the Holy Spirit and are sent forth to complete their mission to make 'disciples out of all'. It is also fitting that we, as Church, take this opportunity to renew our own sense of our mission, and as a parish, to participate in continuing the work that Jesus handed down to the Apostles and to each generation. Our parish Mission and Vision, reminds us of our own responsibility to work toward making 'disciples of all'.

With a Mission and Vision in mind, the Strategic Planning Committee has worked on a number of items. The focus of this first phase of work was to build an understanding of who we are as a parish and to gain a better sense of all that we currently do. Toward that end, much time was spent documenting current activities in all aspects of parish life.

Here are some of the highlights:

- Ministries participated in an initial survey to help us gain a more comprehensive view and a better understanding of the rich array of ministries present at the parish. In doing so, we've begun to identify ways in which we can be more supportive of parish ministries and we're continuing these discussions with the different ministries to make sure that we are good stewards of the resource of time and talent that is so generously given by the people of St. Matthew.
- We've worked with and refined the Mission and Vision with the Parish Council, Finance Council, staff and ministries.
- We've looked at our financial practices as a parish in an effort to ensure that we are good stewards of our financial resources. In doing so, we've made adjustments to our policies and procedures and are currently in the process of implementing the "Best Practices" outlined by the Archdiocese.
- We've looked at our organizational model to gain an understanding of how we currently meet the needs of the parish community and how to best position ourselves to better meet the needs of our parish community.
- We've started a process by which we'll be asking you, as members of this parish, to help us ensure we're meeting the needs of the parish by coming to you with ideas and questions. The first of this was related to an electronic contribution option. Now that we've tabulated the survey results, we are currently evaluating the costs v's benefits of providing an electronic contribution option.

A lot of work has gone on behind the scenes to help set up a strong foundation for implementing the Strategic Planning work that started with the Executive Service Corps work. In order to set our future course, we need to have a good understanding of where we're coming from and who we are as parish community. Over the next few months, the Strategic Planning Committee will be working closely with the Parish Pastoral Council, the Finance Council, the Parish Religious Education Board, the staff and ministries as our focus shifts from what we've done in the past toward how we will work to build our future. In the upcoming weeks and months, you receive more frequent updates regarding the Strategic Plan as our work becomes more future-focused and visible.

From time to time, we'll be asking for your input and support in our efforts to live out our mission of discipleship as the faith community of St. Matthew's. Perhaps you're interested in a particular ministry or have some time to share your talents. In the upcoming weeks we'll have more opportunities to get involved as we continue our work and I ask that you consider how you might want to get involved.
