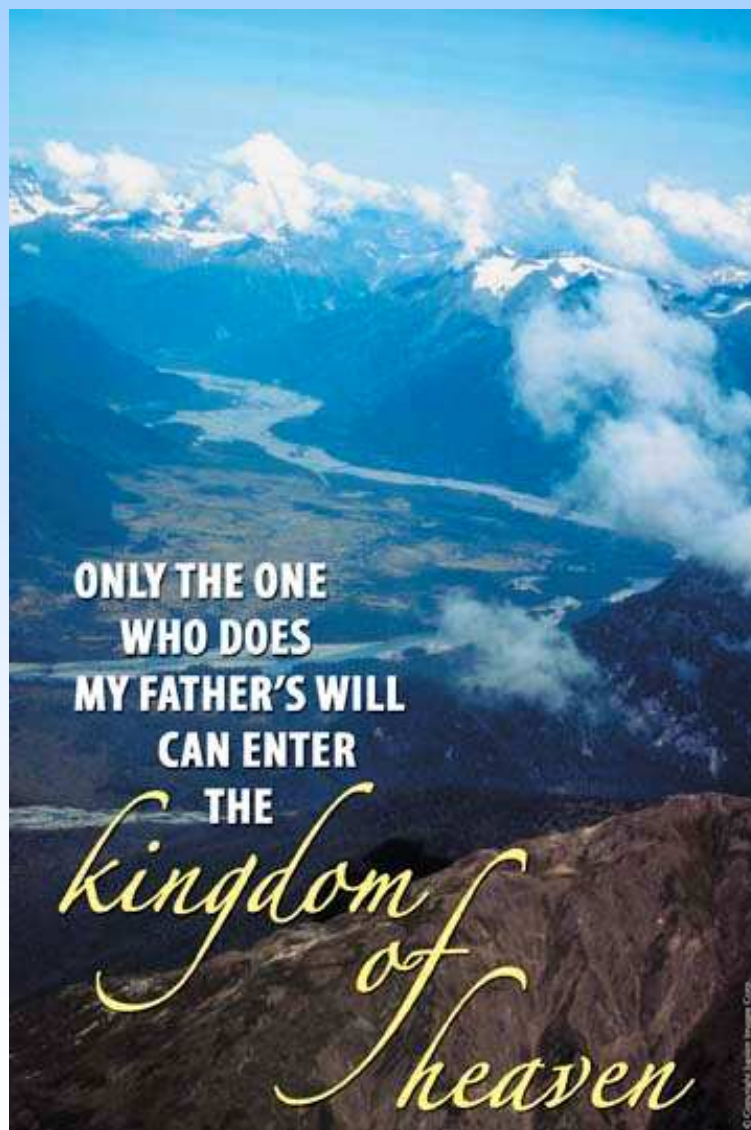

Dear Friends in Christ,

On the weekend of **June 7-8, 2008**, we will begin the first special collection for the **Retired Priests of the Archdiocese**.

We all know how much our ministry in the parishes depends upon the generosity of retired priests and, over the past ten years, I have been edified by the willingness of our retired priests to respond to the call to serve as temporary administrators of parishes, sometimes parishes undergoing great stress and suffering. I want to take this opportunity to thank all of our retired priests for the ministry they do in the parishes of the Archdiocese. Our retired priests make possible an adequate schedule of Masses and sacraments for the faithful. Our retired priests who administer parishes have given new life to many communities. Please accept my thanks and my prayers.

I am thankful to all of you for helping inaugurate this special collection for the retired priests of the Archdiocese. Your generosity and your prayers are a great affirmation of the work of our retired priests. You are in my prayers; please keep me in yours.

- Thank you to **Dennis Basden** and the **RCIA Team: Jennifer Krzak, Bill Davies, Greg Michaels, Glenn Freiburger, Lucy Nowicki** and **Bob Van Deven** for a wonderful program initiating new members into the faith.
- Thank you to **Larry** and **Katie Houle** for their 14 years of work in Youth Ministry here in the parish. Also thank you to **Mr. Jim Weaver** for his many years of service as well. We welcome **Riannon Torres** who will be the new Youth Ministry Director and at one time was a peer minister herself in our program.
- Thank you to **Ed Tummillo** and all the **committee members** who have worked together on the Strategic Planning Team. We're especially grateful that our new parish mission and vision have been finalized and will help us tremendously in all our planning for the future.
- Congratulations to **Thomas Oates** and **Eric Poczatek** who have been awarded the rank of Eagle Scout. They are both members of Boy Scout Troop 496. We wish them well in all their endeavors.
- Thank you and congratulations to all our **parishioners** and **friends** at St. Matthew who participated so generously in the Annual Catholic Appeal Debt Reduction Program. As of May 20, 2008 the donor count is 727 families. Our matching goal was \$69,802. The amount pledged was \$170,920.50. The amount paid is \$109,850, and the balance due is \$61,070. Your outstanding generosity to this special debt reduction program is a wonderful testament to your commitment to St. Matthew Parish. I have no doubt that we may exceed the balance due. Again, thank you for your cooperation and concern for the parish.
- Again, thank you to **all** who gave so generously to this year's Easter Collection. The final contribution was \$70,145.64. Your support of the parish is greatly appreciated.
- The construction of the cell tower has been temporarily delayed until fall by the cellular company for various reasons.
- Based on the survey results regarding electronic giving, the parish finance committee continues to evaluate various alternatives that may be useful as well as cost effective.
- Obviously, not everyone has been recognized for their service to the parish. We will continue to complete this picture in the future, but in the meantime know that we appreciate all you do for St. Matthew Parish.

Baptismal Preparation Meeting

The monthly meeting of the Baptismal Prep Program will take place the first Wednesday of the month June 4th at 7:30 pm in the Hughes Center. This meeting is for the parents and godparents, if available, of the child to be baptized. The dates for baptism are set at these meetings. When attending this meeting all parents must present a photo ID of themselves, as well as a state birth certificate or hospital certificate of the child being baptized. If the child has not been born when you attend this meeting, you must bring proof of the child's birth after he or she is born to the rectory office. This policy has been put into effect for your protection of right of privacy.
