Getting to Know....

Youth Ministry

Youth Ministry is a program for teens to develop and deepen their faith, expand their friendships and serve others. Youth Ministry strives to help busy teens learn to develop an active faith life and have a place in the parish community. The program consists of many elements especially geared for teens and events are open to all High School Students.

Peer Ministry: Peer Ministers are the student leaders in Youth Ministry. They are the voice of the teens and are key to understanding and attending to the real needs of the teens in the parish. They are actively involved in planning, coordinating and running Youth Ministry programs. Peer Ministers apply for and are interviewed for this position.

Outreach Nights: Are held on a Sunday evening of each month during the school year. These nights are a great opportunity for teens to make new friends, discuss important topics, play games, share food, and most importantly, build and deepen their faith. Topics are selected by teens for teens.

Formation: Focuses on the spiritual growth of Peer Ministers and the teens in the parish. Activities include teen liturgies and guest speakers on topics such as faith and spirituality.

Social Justice: Provides the opportunity to have teens experience the joy of service by helping the needy in our community and around the world. Activities include parish-wide food drive, Make a Difference Day and fundraising for programs to address world hunger.

Social: Focuses on building community among the teens in our parish and other parishes. Activities include Fright Fest, Game nights, Ski trips, and other group outings.

Youth Ministry also relies on Youth Ministers or Adult Volunteers who help facilitate all of the above. They are parents, former Peer Ministers or great parishioners who like working with teens and want to create a welcoming environment where teens can be themselves, have fun, share openly, grow spiritually and share with them the joy of serving others.
