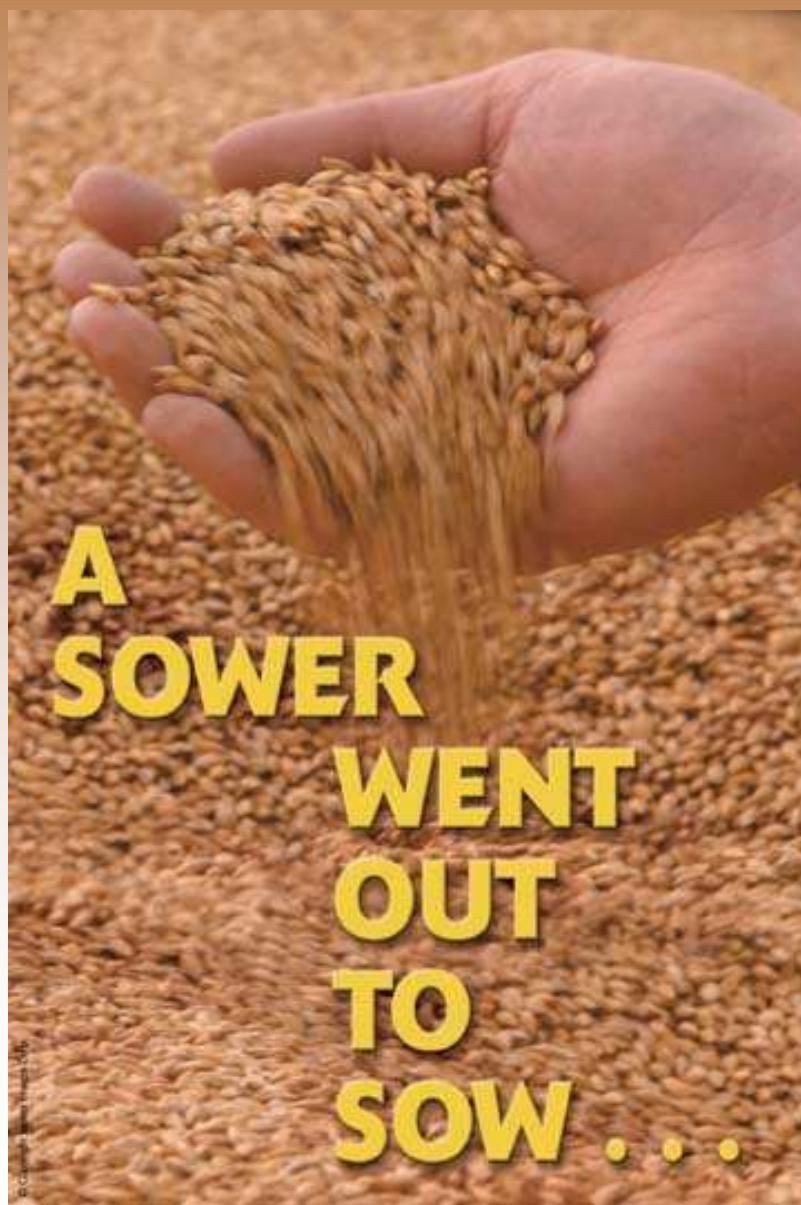

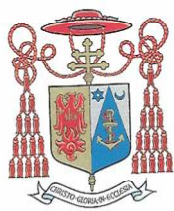

Dear Father Glab,

We have reached the midpoint of the 2008 Annual Catholic Appeal campaign. I am happy to report that the generous people of the Archdiocese of Chicago have already pledged \$14,500,000 – and \$10,600,000 has already been contributed! The credit for this achievement goes directly to our pastors, who inspired their parishioners to donate so generously. Thank you.

Since St. Matthew was selected for debt reduction status in the 2008 Annual Catholic Appeal, the funds your parish raises will be used to reduce the parish debt at the Archdiocesan Bank. In addition, the Archdiocese of Chicago will match, dollar for dollar, the funds raised up to the amount of your parish goal and apply that distribution to your debt as well. This distribution is the first installment for the 2008 Appeal. The final installment will be distributed at the end of the 2008 Annual Catholic Appeal in February 2009.

I am deeply grateful to you for your efforts and for the support of the people of St. Matthew. I am pleased to advise you that \$199,070.04 has been applied to your account and you will see this reduction reflected in your next statement from the Archdiocesan Bank.

God bless you for all that you do so well for the Church of Chicago. I am proud to be your bishop. As you know, you and the parishioners of St. Matthew are always in my prayers. Please remember me in yours. Thank you.

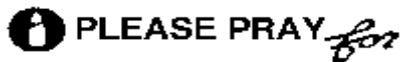
