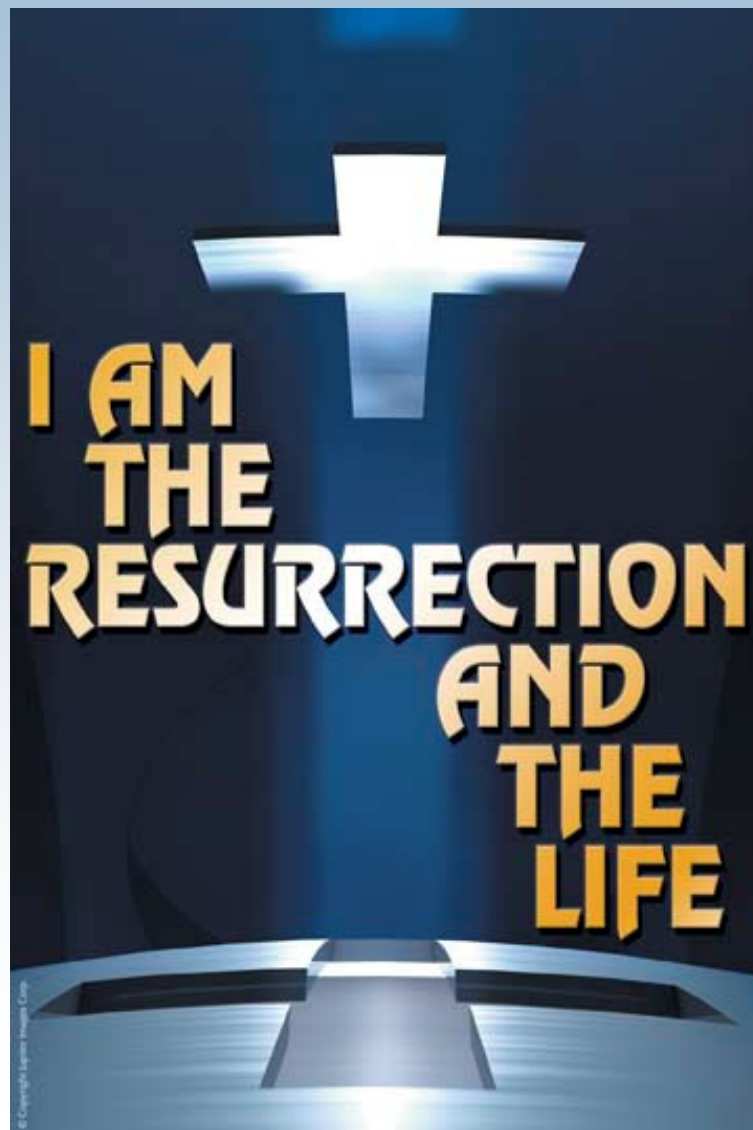

The month of November is dedicated to remembering our loved ones who have crossed the threshold to eternal life. We begin November with the feast of **ALL SAINTS** remembering all those who loved God and taught us, our family, friends and neighbors, by their own quiet example, how to follow Jesus the Christ who is the Way, the Truth and the Life. These loved ones may never be formally canonized, but because they served God faithfully, they are indeed saints.

Every family has such outstanding men and women who inspire us in the ways of the Lord. On November 2nd we celebrate the **Feast of All Souls**. As far back as the eleventh century Christians have prayed for their loved ones that they "may rest in peace" as they await the final judgment of God.

A green vigil light will burn symbolizing Christ as the **HOPE** of the living and the dead.

Baptismal Preparation Meeting

The monthly meeting of the Baptismal Prep Program will take place the first Wednesday of the month, November 4, at 7:30 pm in the Hughes Center. This meeting is for the parents and godparents, if available, of the child to be baptized. The dates for baptism are set at these meetings. When attending this meeting all parents must present a photo ID of themselves, as well as a state birth certificate or hospital certificate of the child being baptized. If the child has not yet been born when you attend this meeting, you must bring proof of the child's birth after he or she is born to the rectory office. This policy has been put into effect for the protection of your right of privacy.

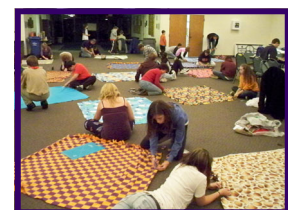
Dear St. Matthew Community,

Thank you to all the hard working volunteers and Confirmation students that cut and tied blankets at St. Matthew Hughes Center on Sunday, October 11, 2009.
