Dear Confirmation Parents:

Over the next several weeks, you will be receiving more information from us related to the steps we need to take to ensure that your teen is ready for Confirmation on **Tuesday, April 25th, 2023**. The Mass will be at 7:00pm. For your planning purposes, I suggest you plan for the ceremony and pictures to take at least 2 hours. This is the current plan, subject to change based on the pandemic.

The first step will be for your teen to select a Sponsor. You'll find a sponsor form included with this letter. I ask that you and your teen review the form select a Sponsor and **return the completed sponsor form and Confirmation Registry Form to us no later than December 2, 2022.**

I am asking that you work with your teen to answer the questions contained within the enclosed Confirmation packet. All questions are due no later than March 6, 2023. The goal of the assignment is for them to put into their own words what they have learned in preparation for Confirmation. I encourage you to work with them on this assignment. **It must be sent to us, as a pdf attachment, from your email to ensure you've had the chance to review their response, as well.** I'm sure you'll find that the assignment won't take them a lot of extra time for research but it is meant to help them come to a better understanding of what the Sacrament of Confirmation is all about.

The teens are expected to attend Sunday Mass at least twice a month at St. Matthew. This requirement is in effect from this month through Confirmation. In addition, they should be completing and submitting a monthly service project related to one of the Works of Mercy.

A reminder ~ I would like you to write a letter to your teen. The goal of the letter is to let them know that you are proud of them ~ why Confirmation is something you think is important; and include some things you would like to say to them. The letter becomes a keepsake for them and will be opened by them later this year. Please place the letter in the enclosed white envelope ~ seal it, and please address it to them. **The Confirmation assignment, including your sealed letter to your teen is to be returned to us by March 6, 2023.**

The Sponsor's role is to assist the person in Christian Initiation. Also, together with the parent, the Sponsor presents the student for the Sacrament and helps to guide the student to live a life of holiness as a baptized Catholic. Being a sponsor is not just an honor given to a good friend or relative. Sponsorship implies a real appreciation of our Catholic Faith, a lifestyle that proclaims the truth, and sense of responsibility toward the young person being confirmed.

Please read the requirements for sponsorship before signing!
Canon 874 and 892 of the Code of Canon Law lists these requirements for the valid and lawful sponsorship for Confirmation:

A SPONSOR:

- Must be at least 16 years of age. Must be mature enough to undertake this responsibility.
- Must have received the three Sacraments of Initiation: Baptism, Eucharist and Confirmation.
- Must know and believe in the fundamental truths of the Faith and be a practicing Catholic who attends Mass on Sunday and receives the Sacraments regularly.
- If married, the sponsor must have been married in the Catholic Church. If single, the sponsor must be living singly according to the Church's teaching.
- Must not be the father or mother of the one to be confirmed.

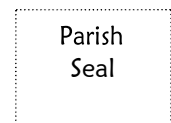

#1: Confirmation Name Selection

Please share why you chose this person to be your sponsor for the Sacrament of Confirmation. Give examples of how your sponsor is living their life as a role model and a disciple of Jesus Christ. What quality of your sponsor do you think is most important? What is the most important thing that your sponsor has taught you?

#3: The Ten Commandments

Assignment:

In your own words, please explain each of the 10 Commandments.

- First, list the actual Commandment.
- Then, in your own words, explain what the Commandment means.
- Give an example of how someone follows the Commandment and
- An example of how one might break or disobey this Commandment.

Please type your response using full paragraphs. Be sure to include your name.

#4: What does Confirmation Mean to Me?

Assignment:

In your own words,

- Please explain what the Sacrament of Confirmation means to you and why you want to receive it.
- What have you learned about the Sacrament of Confirmation and why is it important?

Please type your response using full paragraphs. Be sure to include your name.

#5: The Sunday Mass

Assignment: Answer the following questions:

- Why are Catholics required to go to Mass on Sunday (or Saturday evening)?
- What does the Mass mean?
- Why are we supposed to go each week?
- What happens at Mass? What important event does each Mass celebrate?
- Why do we choose Sunday (instead of another day) as the day on which we must go to Mass?
